The calls break down to 1 Fire, 50 Rescue & EMS, 1 Hazardous Condition, 7 Service Calls, 16 Good Intent Calls, and 1 False Alarm. ii. Chief's Notes. The two Type 6 Engines will be completed on Friday. Two a. people will fly down and drive them back. The vehicles will then go to Hillsboro for lights and sirens on Monday. Because of vendor issues we are a month behind schedule. Board Members now have a binder with the Government b. Camp Remodel Cost Analysis. The next step is Blane getting together with Attorney John Watts to develop a General RFP. Then the project can be put out to bid. Solar Eclipse on August 21st. Oregon is estimating a million C. visitors coming in for the Eclipse. There is a big concern about the high possibility of illegal camping due to everything being overbooked. Big concerns regarding increase in traffic emergency calls, and wildfire potential.
